Trend

Healthy individuals and families are the backbone of strong communities. When people have the opportunity to connect with others and access services in their neighbourhoods they are more likely to overcome life's challenges. However, there are a growing number of people across the Capital Regional District (CRD) that suffer from social isolation and do not know where to turn.



Goal

United Way works to create lasting change by addressing the social conditions that leave people vulnerable. With your support in 2016, United Way invested \$1,455,645 to improve the quality of life for individuals and families facing challenges of isolation and personal crisis.

As a result, you helped fund 53 programs and services to:

- Support individuals to overcome mental health and addiction challenges
- Address the impacts of domestic violence
- Assist isolated seniors, newcomers and people with disabilities to connect with others and build meaningful relationships



Your Donor Dollars Make an Impact

- \$1/day** 24 youth access a peer support program to help them adjust to their new community
- \$10/pay** 10 weeks of financial education training for 1 woman who has experienced domestic violence to assist her in living independently
- \$20/pay** 4 seniors receive support and companionship following their hospitalization
- \$50/pay** 7 families of children with special needs receive a night away to rejuvenate and manage stress from their daily lives
